In order to join, you must fill out an application form and pay your annual dues of \$40.00 and a \$5.00 one-time initiation fee. Our meetings are held at the Minnesota Valley Country Club. Below you will find out some information about the club, and if you have any other questions, please feel free to contact me.

The objective of the club is to be charitable. We support two scholarships each year for two talented young women: one year from Kennedy, the next year from Jefferson. One scholarship is for a woman who will attend a 4-year college and one scholarship is for a woman who will attend Normandale Community College.

We also support VEAP, Cornerstone, Oasis, the March of Dimes, and various other charities. In order to earn money to donate to these worthwhile causes, we have an annual fundraiser every Fall. According to our By-Laws, each member is required to support this fundraiser, so we are asking each member to try to sell three reservations or, if not, to please make a donation. In addition, we work at the CUB bratwurst stand located in Valley West and earn money that way. We also have raffles and drawings in which you may, or may not, participate.

We meet the third Wednesday of every month for lunch, a program and a business meeting. Members are called each month to see if they plan to attend the meeting, and the caller then makes a reservation for you for lunch. You must have a reservation in order to be served lunch. If a reservation is made and something comes up that prohibits you from attending, you are still responsible for the fee (currently \$19.00) unless it is cancelled by the Monday noon before the meeting. You will receive a monthly newsletter either by e-mail, or, if you prefer, by US Mail. We also ask that you serve on a hostess committee once a year. This consists of helping decorate for the luncheon and staffing the registration desk to check in members and receive these luncheon payments.
